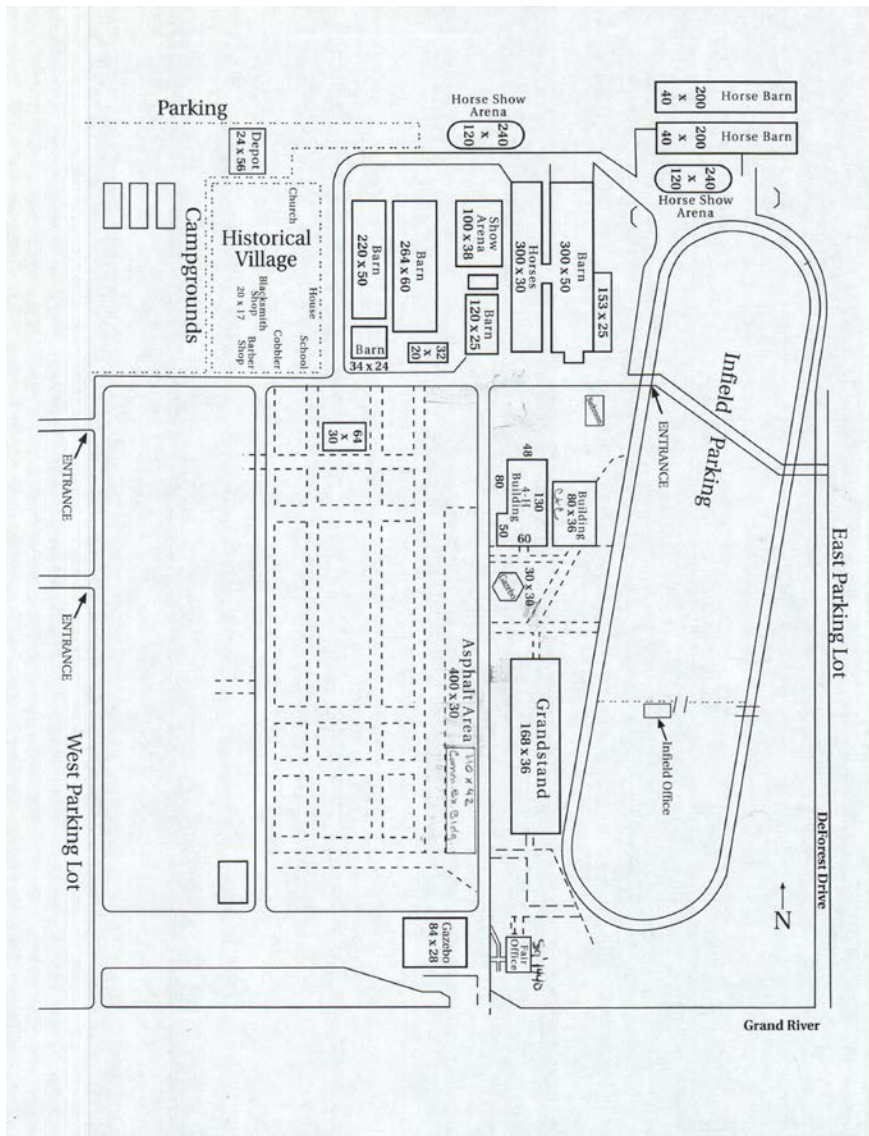
General Information

- Please check-in with the Show Office when you arrive to register your team.
- Slot sheets must be emailed to the show secretary no later than Wednesday, September 30 at 12:00 PM. Her e-mail address is district11dc@outlook.com
- **Shavings will not be available for purchase at the facility, please bring your own.**
- Stalls **MUST BE STRIPPED** prior to leaving the grounds
- Checks must be made payable to **MIHA Region B**.
- Team duties will be assigned and distributed via email before September 30, 2020.
- Additional duties will be assigned as needed.
- The top 2 of the 4 teams competing in each division will go to State Championships.
- All equitation classes will require a pattern and top riders will be called back for rail work.
- All patterns (except those provided in our rulebook) were randomly selected by the MIHA Patterns Committee.
- You are responsible for downloading and printing your own copies of the patterns. Patterns will be posted **September 28th, 2020** on www.miha.org under the Patterns section. **Patterns will not be provided in the registration packet or in the show office.**
- It is your responsibility to notify the Regional Chairperson if your team is not attending the Regional Championship.

Camping Rules

1. Upon arrival, campers must check in with the Office for their sites location and camping permits. The Permits must be displayed in the camping unit. ALL PERMITS MUST FACE ROADSIDE.
2. NO SWITCHING OF SITES will be granted without authorization from office. Those who are found changing sites will be asked to leave and will not receive refund.
3. Each campsite will be required to have a responsible adult (age 18 or above) staying in the camper at night and their name listed on the application form for supervising younger members of the camping group. The names of all the members of the camping group shall be listed on the application and the name and phone number of the person or persons to contact in case of an emergency. This will be strictly enforced.
4. Campers are to be quiet after 11:00pm – This will be strictly enforced.
5. No illegal drugs will be allowed on the grounds.
6. No dumping of wastewater on the grounds except in the dumping station.
7. All water hoses and trailer connections MUST not leak. If this becomes a problem they will be disconnected by the campgrounds supervisor.
8. Electrical cords MUST be a 12 gauge or better with the proper ground.
9. Fire lanes are to be kept clear at all times.
10. If you have animals (pets) you are responsible for clean-up. The animal MUST be kept quiet (if possible) and at your site unless on a leash with you. During events, animals (pets) are NOT allowed in public areas. MUST be kept at campsite.
11. Campfires must be kept contained. Please see office.
12. A maximum of six people will be allowed to stay in any one campsite.
13. Any camper or member of a camping group who violates any of these rules will have their camper permit revoked. They will be required to leave the fairgrounds and remove their camper from the grounds or they will be removed. Camping fees will be forfeited and no refunds will be made.
14. All hitches must be readily accessible (for emergency hookup).
