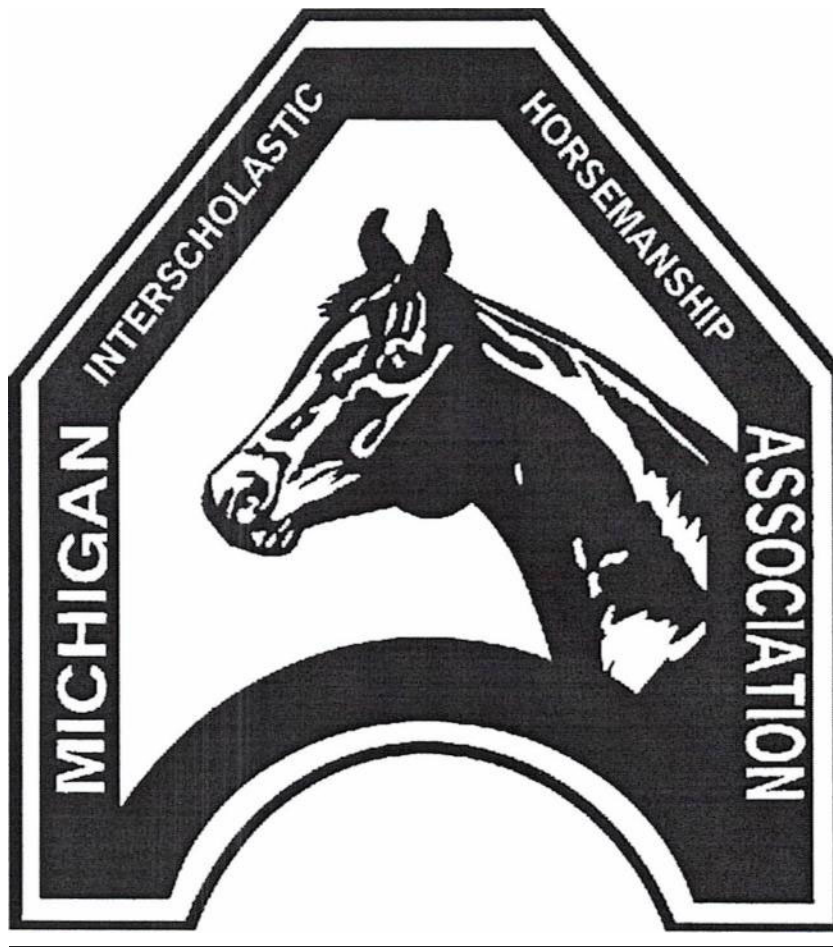

Prior to the meet:

1. Email payment sheet to Hidie Morford hmorford@hotmail.com by **6pm Wednesday September 21, 2022** a. Teams will be charged for the number of stalls and camp sites recorded on the payment sheet.
2. **Slot sheets MUST be emailed to Hidie Morford by 6pm Wednesday September 21, 2022**
3. All horses must be in a stall. Showing out of a trailer is NOT allowed.
4. Please **NO SCREEN SHOTS!** These do not come through readable.

Friday.

Coaches meeting: 12pm in Barn 24 in the common area

- Teams may arrive at the fairgrounds beginning at 8am.
- District chairperson must deliver their team's rider registration forms to the show office by 12pm.
- All coaches must report to the office by 12pm on Friday to verify slot sheets and pay.
 - No badges or back numbers will be released without payment.
- 2 badges per team. If a team has more than 2 coaches, they must share badges.
 - Only coaches or assistant coaches can register the team or make class changes.
 - The coach/assistant coach must show the badge to make class changes.
- :* All class changes must be in writing; Slot sheets must be free of marks of any kind.

Saturday.

- Coaches Meeting 7:15am in barn 24 common area
- Show starts promptly at 8:30am.
- Coaches meeting to discuss Sunday schedule will be 15 minutes after the conclusion of the last event on Saturday.in barn 24 common area

Classes begin @ 8am.

Closing ceremonies will be an announcement, we suggest you take your photos outside perhaps by the fairground sign. This is not how we want to do it but with Covid procedures in place this is the only option.

Rules

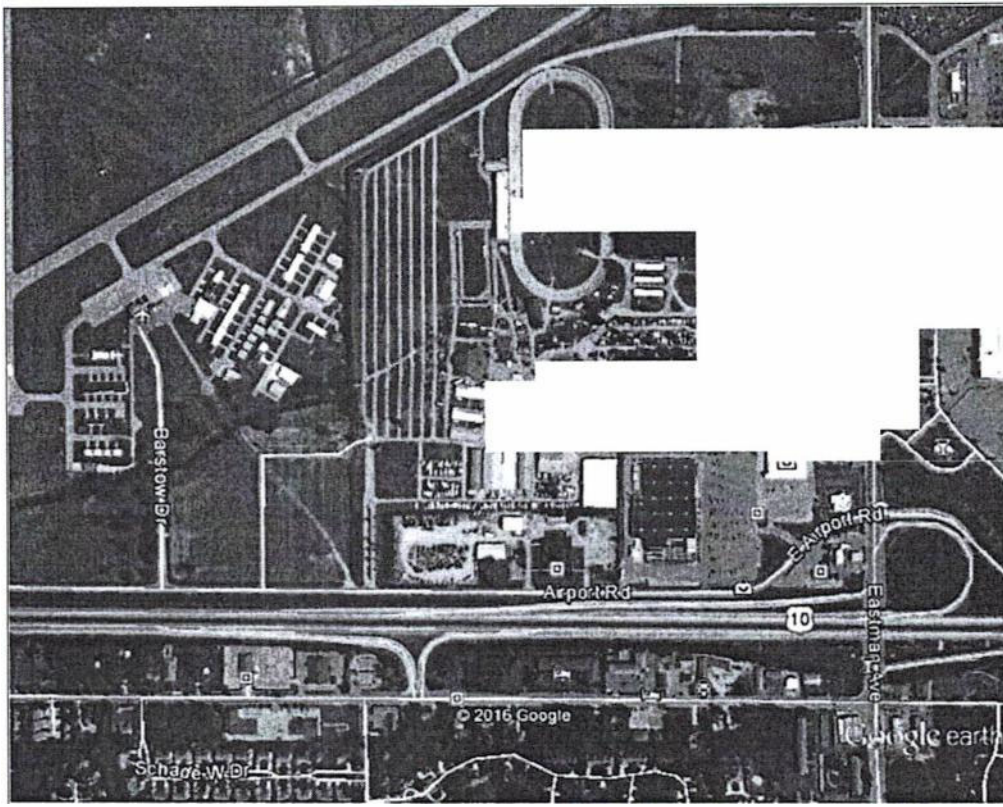
- **Dogs allowed in camping area only. (you must provide the show office with proof of shots)**
 - Must be kept on a leash and under control at all times.
 - Please clean up after your dog.
- **Camping will be assigned by the show committee. NO SHAPES, PARK ON YOUR SPACE!!!!!!**
- Stalls do not have to be cleaned. Only pine shavings are allowed in stalls.
- You may decorate the stalls; do not use tape, staples, nails, screws, etc.
- **Horses are NOT allowed on the grass (anywhere) or in the camping area, this includes the roads.**
- **No riding in the barns, grass, campground or in off limit areas.**
- No riding double or with just a HALTER at any time.
- Shavings will NOT be available; please bring your own.
- No horses in barns until Friday—no exceptions.
- Fires are allowed but must be in a fire pit with a grate on top.
- New Barns: You may not drive between Barn 18 and the New barn. You will NOT FIT!!!! There will be gates up

Midland County Fair — Camping Policy

- 1 Campers may set up their camping vehicles or tents on their lots starting the Thursday previous to the meet. **You are not allowed to plug into electricity or start camping until 8:00 a.m. Friday morning. This is checked and you will be charged.**
2. Those renting lots are responsible for any illegal activity or other actions deemed unsuitable by the camping committee. This will result in loss of the lot and you will be asked to vacate the lot immediately.
3. Stay within your lot boundaries. This includes slide out units. You will be moved if parked incorrectly. If you are unsure, please come to the office and someone will assist you.
4. Lots must be occupied with a trailer or a tent the entire weekend. A canopy, picnic table, car, etc. on the lot will not be considered as occupied.
5. **You may have the cage type firepits but not RINGS in the campground. Your firepit must have cage on top.**
6. No motorcycles, skateboards, bicycles, push scooters or roller blades are allowed on the grounds.
7. **Do not park on road or block the road.**
8. No vehicles in buildings. No smoking in buildings.
9. Off road vehicle rules are in effect when the vehicle is unloaded at the fairgrounds.
 - See detailed Off Road Vehicle Rules & Restricted Driving Area on the Midland County website.
10. The penalty for campers, who violate camping rules, off road vehicle rules or vehicle parking rules, could result in the loss of team points.
11. **Garbage must be put into the dumpsters at the end of each camp road. DO NOT TAKE TRASH CANS FROM THE BARN!**
